RODNEY G. DENNIS, Curator of Manuscripts in the Harvard College Library, is the author of several articles, including "Friedrich Gottlieb Klopstock and John Flaxman" in the January 1968 HARVARD LIBRARY BULLETIN.

C. P. MACGREGOR has written a Cambridge University dissertation, "The Poetry of Christ: Christopher Smart's *Jubilate Agno*, its structure, logic, and place in the development of his work."

DONALD STONE, JR., Professor of Romance Languages and Literatures at Harvard, has contributed articles to the January 1969 and April 1972 issues of the HARVARD LIBRARY BULLETIN and is the author of several books, including *Ronsard's Sonnet Cycles* (1966), *France in the Sixteenth Century* (1969), and *From Tales to Truth: Essays on French Fiction in the Sixteenth Century* (1973).

DAVID M. VIETH is Professor of English at Southern Illinois University; the Yale University Press published his *Attribution in Restoration Poetry* (1963) and his edition of *The Complete Poems of John Wilmot, Earl of Rochester* (1968), and his articles include a number of contributions to the *Papers* of the Bibliographical Society of America.
